Side Menu Options

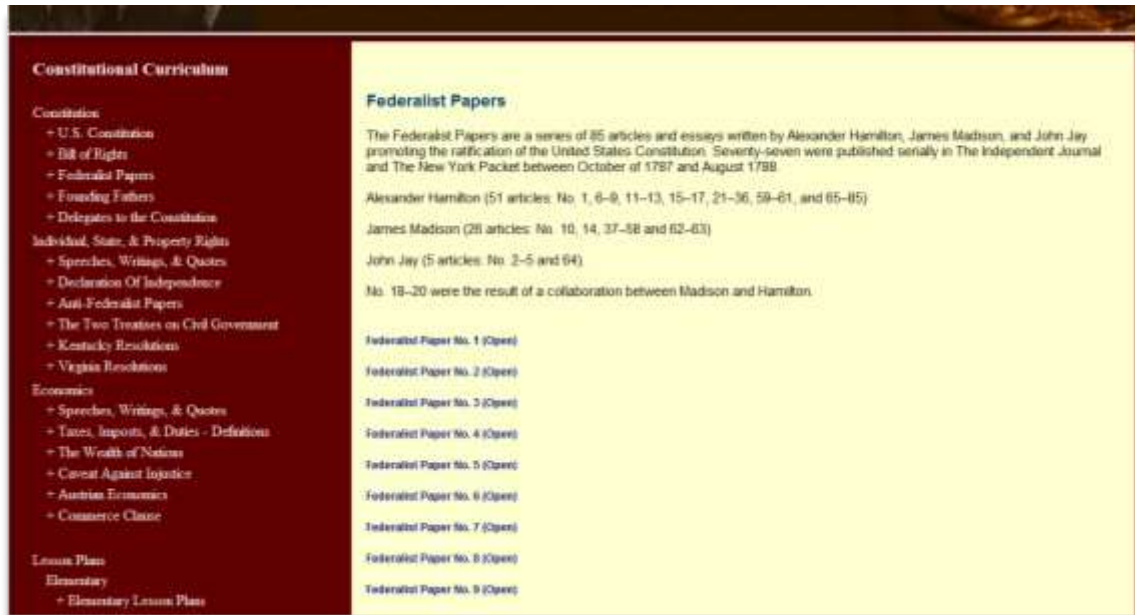

- Individual, State, & Property Rights > Speeches, Writings, & Quotes
- Individual, State, & Property Rights > Declaration of Independence
- Individual, State, & Property Rights > Anti-Federalist Papers

Opening a document

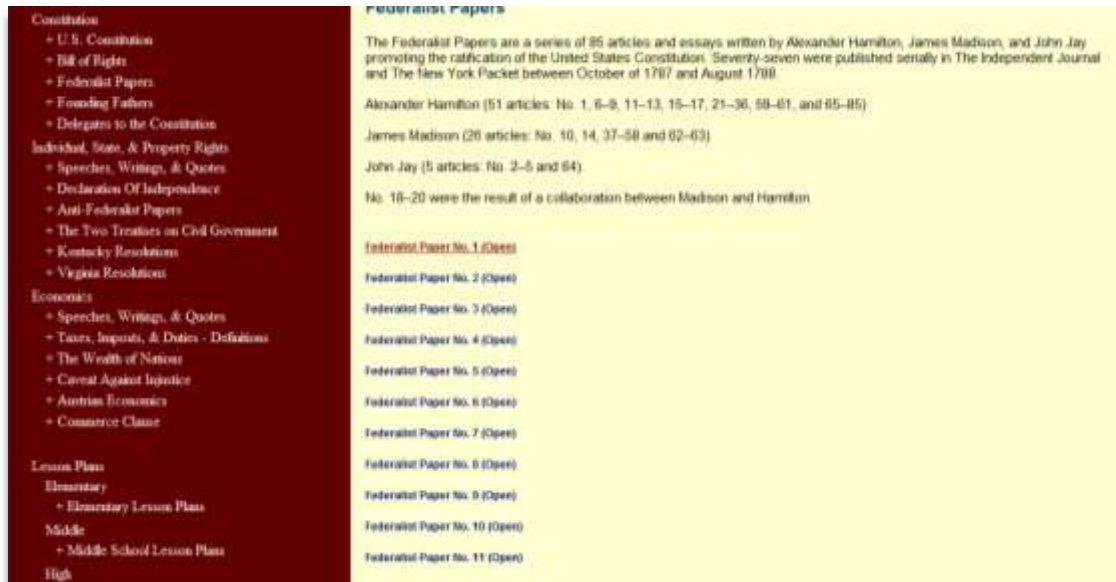

If the user clicks on the link, another tab window will display showing the document (.pdf format). See figure 5.0.

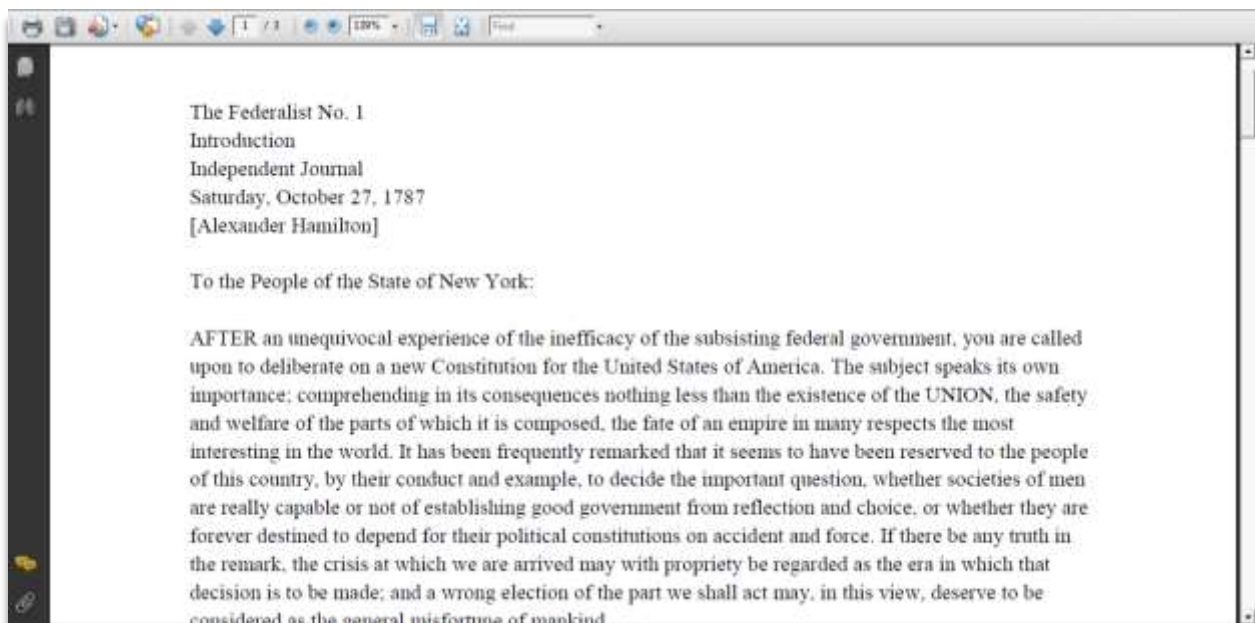
